1. The petitioner herein is a minor child of estranged parents, who are litigating in the Court. The petitioner through his mother submitted an application for issuance of passport on 08.04.2024. He complains that no passport has been issued.
2. Per contra, learned counsel for the respondents submits that the petitioner's mother is required to submit declaration/affidavit in the form of Annexure C, as provided in the guidelines.
3. Keeping in view the facts of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner's mother to fulfill the requirement as provided in Annexure C within a period of two weeks to enable the Regional Passport Officer, concerned to process petitioner's application within next four weeks.
