1. The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in case bearing No.CRA/1095/2018 titled as 'Surinder Kumar Vs. Ranbir Singh' wherein vide order dated 25.09.2024 (Annexure P-7) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala, bail bonds of the petitioner have been forfeited.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner is willing and ready to appear, and surrender before the Appellate Court. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the Appellate Court, and directions be given to the Trial Court that his application of bail/suspension of sentence, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. H.S. Deol, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2-State.

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5. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Appellate Court within seven days from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

6. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Appellate Court within seven days from today, this order shall be of no avail to him, thereafter. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail/suspension of sentence, the Appellate Court shall decide it in accordance with law.
