The prayer in this fifth petition under Section 483 read with Section 528 of the BNSS is for the grant of interim bail for 30 days to the petitioner in case FIR No.44 dated 08.03.2023 under Sections 307, 392, 342, 34, 325, 394 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar, Punjab on account of death of his mother.

Looking at the facts and circumstances of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to grant interim bail to the petitioner. However, in view of the fact that the mother of the petitioner passed away on 14.12.2024, the Jail Superintendent concerned is directed to send the petitioner/Gurmeet Singh in custody to the place including the Gurudwara Sahib where the

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rituals are to be performed between 8.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m. for three days i.e. w.e.f. 28.12.2024 to 30.12.2024. The expenses incurred for the aforesaid purpose shall be borne by the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of.
