Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 7 to register FIR or/and conduct fair and impartial investigation in regard to the merciless beating or attempt to murder of Narender Singh petitioner No.2 and for the harassment caused to the petitioners and their family members, whereby as per the medical report/MLC/MLR and other medical records of petitioner No.2, *prima facie* physical assault was detected and no action has been taken by the police till date.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that there is a matrimonial dispute between the petitioners and respondents No.8 to 10. He submits that petitioner No.2 has already filed a divorce petition against his wife i.e. respondent No.9 and on account of the same, brother-in-law of petitioner No.2 i.e. respondent No.8 had given him injuries, where he suffered fracture in his leg. He submits that the petitioners have already filed a representation dated 18.07.2024 (Annexure P-9) for taking legal action against the respondent-accused, copy of which has been sent to respondent No.4, however, no action has been taken on the same till date.
