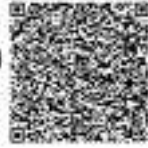

The present petition has been filed for seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Quo Warranto for calling upon respondents No.7 to 11 as to how they are holding the official post despite being not eligible for the same.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners contends that he gives up his primary prayer and confines his prayer to the alternative relief i.e. issuance of a direction to the Deputy Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Kurukshetra to take a decision on the pending complaint No.CMOFF/N/2022/128789 dated 22.11.2022 in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Pankaj Mulwani, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and Mr. Vivek Saini, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.5; and they have no objection to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Deputy Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Kurukshetra to take an expeditious decision on the pending complaint mentioned above in a time bound manner and preferably within a period of four months of the receipt of certified copy of this order and after granting an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties.
