SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The petitioner is an aspirant for admission to MD/MS course under General Category in UT Pool.
2. The grievance of the petitioner is that she uploaded certain requisite documents, a little late, i.e. after 4.00 PM on the extended date of 21.11.2024 stipulated for the same as per the revised schedule of time line (vide page 15 of the paper-book).
3. The Residence Certificate, duly attested by Tehsildar, U.T. Chandigarh, undoubtedly was submitted by the petitioner after 4.00 PM on 21.11.2024.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to point out any enabling provision in the prospectus or any other Rules/Regulations, which bestows any discretion to the competent authority to relax the last date for submission of requisite documents.
5. The time line provided for admission to profession courses is sacrosanct. (Please see : **Parshvanath Charitable Trust and others Vs. All India Council for Technical Education and others, (2013) 3 SCC 385**).
6. In view of the above, this Court cannot help the petitioner.
7. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
