1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is entitled for a higher salary for the period 01.04.2014 till 21.10.2015 keeping in view the emoluments admissible to the post on which the petitioner was working, which are not being paid to the petitioner.

Learned counsel further submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised in the legal notice dated 01.10.2024, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-10, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the respondents be directed to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Ms. Shruti, AAG, Punjab who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 01.10.2024 (Annexure P-10), has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of 08 weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
