HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. By this common order, three writ petitions, the details of which
have been given in the heading, are being disposed of as all these petitions
involve the same question of law on similar facts.

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2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that as the impugned order dated 14.03.2023 (Annexure P-9) has been passed by the District Education Officer (Elementary Education), Gurdaspur, the petitioner(s) intend to approach the higher authorities to protest that the certificate which is being termed as a fake or “not genuine” is incorrect as the certificate of experience, which was produced by the petitioner(s) was given by the School after the petitioner(s) had discharged the duties, which was duly counter signed by the officials before granting appointment to the petitioner(s).

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) further submits that the only apprehension of the petitioner(s) is that even if the petitioner(s) approach the higher authorities, their claim will not be considered in a time bound manner, which will cause further prejudice to the petitioner(s) as the petitioner(s) were out of service for the last more than one year.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation/appeal is preferred against the impugned order dated 14.03.2023 (Annexure P-9) passed by the District Education Officer (Elementary Education), Gurdaspur to a higher authority, the same will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of

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this order.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State, the present writ petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

8. Ordered accordingly.
