1. The petitioner-minor child prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to issue fresh passport, as per application submitted on 27.11.2024. He was born on 28.11.2019. His father is settled abroad. He is living in the custody of his mother through whom the present petition has been filed.

2. Mr. Prajwal Chauhan, Advocate has entered appearance pursuant to supply of advance copy of petition on behalf of the respondents and submits that the petitioner's mother is required to file proper declaration as provided in Annexure C. It is submitted that as and when the proper declaration in the form of Annexure C is submitted, the petitioner's request for passport shall be processed and decided.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of while directing the petitioner's mother to submit fresh declaration in the form provided in Annexure C, which shall be processed by Regional Passport Officer, Jalandhar, within next six weeks from the date of declaration is submitted.



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4. With the above observations, the present writ petition is disposed of.
