1. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner has applied for compassionate appointment as her husband, who was working as a Sweeper-cum-Chowkidar in the Govt. Middle School, Julani Khera, for 16 years, had passed away on 12.06.2024, leaving behind her and two minor children. The representation (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner, has been forwarded on 10.07.2024 by the Headmaster of the said school to the Block Education Officer, but the same has yet not been decided. He thus, at this stage, on instructions, prays that a direction be given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Dushyant Saharan, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and has no objection to the limited prayer made.

4. In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation (Annexure P-5) within 03 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to her and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to her interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioner shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
