1. Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners are entitled for minimum of the pay scale along arrears keeping in view the judgment of this Court in **CWP-26367 of 2018 titled 'Pritpal Kaur and others Vs. State of Punjab and another decided on 25.11.2024** therefore, appropriate directions be issued to the respondents to grant the benefit of minimum pay scale along with the arrears forthwith as, the benefit to the similarly situated persons has already been granted by this Court while passing order in **Pritpal Singh (supra)**.

2. Learned counsel submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised the said claim in the legal notice dated 22.10.2024 (Annexure P-7), which is still pending consideration with the

respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, that the



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respondents be directed to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Ms. Shruti, AAG, Punjab who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 22.10.2024 (Annexure P-7), has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of 08 weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be conveyed to the petitioners for his information and necessary action.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
6. Ordered accordingly.
