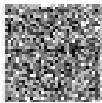

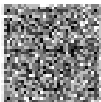

ANIL KSHETARPAL, J(Oral)

1. The petitioner prays for interim bail in a case bearing No.152, dated 04.09.2023 registered under Section 21 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran, Punjab.
2. The petitioner's wife has been advised surgical procedure to remove her gall-bladder on account of gall-bladder stone.
3. On 24.12.2024, learned State counsel was directed to seek instructions.
4. Mr. Salil Sabhlok, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has informed the Court that surgical procedure is scheduled to be carry out today itself.
5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant interim bail particularly when allegation against the petitioner are serious as he along with his co-accused are stated to be engaged in distribution of heroin.
6. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
