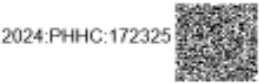

1. The prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5, who have married against the wishes of private respondents.
2. Notice of motion.
3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Jasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.
4. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Raman Kumar has informed that statement of petitioner No.2-Gursewak Singh was recorded after receiving the representation dated 21.12.2024 (Annexure P-5) by Kabal Singh, Head Constable, Police Station Ghanaur, whereby he has stated that the private respondents have now agreed for the marriage solemnized by both the petitioners



and there is no apprehension of threat to the petitioners.

5. In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
