JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect her life, liberty and property which is in danger at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5.
2. The petitioner is a 71 years old widow of Samarjit Singh. She is residing in Ludhiana. One lady namely Parminder Kaur who was citizen of Singapore executed Will in her favour. It is apt to notice that petitioner is daughter-in-law of Parminder Kaur. The husband of petitioner passed away during the lifetime of Parminder Kaur. She solemnized marriage with nephew of Parminder Kaur. The respondents No.4 and 5 are nephews of Parminder Kaur and they are filing multiple civil and criminal cases against petitioner with intent to extort property which she has received in view of Will executed by Parminder Kaur.

Despite closure of different complaints, the respondents No.4 and 5 are filing complaints before different Police Stations and harassing her. They are also resorting remedy of criminal complaint before Magistrate. The petitioner has filed representation dated 18.12.2024 (Annexure P-20) before Police Commissioner, Ludhiana wherein she has brought on record complete facts and figures with respect to herself and private respondents.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Inderjeet Singh Ladher, DAG, Punjab who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and waives service.
5. With consent of learned counsel for the parties, the case is taken up for final disposal.
6. Learned State counsel assures that jurisdictional Police Commissioner would look into representation dated 18.12.2024 (Annexure P-20) and do the needful in accordance with law.
7. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to aforesaid arrangement.
8. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
