ORDER

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1. The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. seeks the following prayers:

- “a) issue appropriate directions to the Ld. Trial Court of Ld. ASJ (Spl. FTC) North-West, Rohini Courts, Delhi in SC No. 319/2022 FIR No. 249/18 PS: South Rohini titled as "State Vs Mohit Rajpal" to conclude the trial expeditiously;
- b) pass such other and further order as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice.”

2. Progress report has been received from the concerned learned Trial Court, wherein it is mentioned that the matter is fixed for prosecution evidence and PW-1/prosecutrix has been partly examined and further examination was deferred and the same was listed within a short period of
