2. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 CrPC seeking direction to the respondent to decide the application of parole filed by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had filed an application seeking parole on 19.12.2023 on the ground that the marriage of his sister is scheduled on 03.02.2024, however, 20 days have elapsed since the date of application but till date no decision has been taken by the
