CRL.M.A. 10144/2024 (delay of 50 days in filing CRL.M.A. 10143/2024)

1. By way of present application filed under Section 5 of Limitation Act, the applicant seeks condonation of delay of 50 days in filing CRL.M.A. 10143/2024.
2. Issue notice.
3. Learned APP for the State accepts notice.
4. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and the delay of 50 days in filing CRL.M.A. 10143/2024 is condoned.
5. The application is disposed of.

CRL.M.A. 10143/2024 (to furnish compliance report)

1. By way of present application filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks to furnish compliance report w.r.t the order dated 16.01.2024.



2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the cost in terms of the order dated 16.01.2024 has been deposited, though the same has been paid after a delay of 40 days.
3. In view of the above, the present application is allowed, subject to payment of further cost of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited with the Delhi State Legal Services Authority (A/c No.: 18580110053263, Bank: UCO BANK, Branch: Rouse Avenue, IFSC: UCBA0003364) within a period of four weeks from today.
