1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.

2. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions. Application is disposed of.

O.M.P.(MISC.)(COMM.) 29/2024

3. This is a petition under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of the mandate of the Arbitrator.

4. The dispute in the present matter pertains to non-payment of dues by the Respondent for transportation of security paper/other, material/machine, consignments from Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust (NHVA-SHEVA)/various DGS&D godowns/ports at Mumbai.

5. It is noticed from the petition that the Petitioner's claim is for a sum of only Rs.3,02,432/-. Arbitral proceedings are at the final stage. Accordingly, the mandate is extended by six months.

6. Respondent shall consider to settle the claims of the Petitioner if any award is passed, so that further litigation can be avoided as the amount



claimed is not very substantial.

7. The petition is disposed of.
