1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner with the following prayers:-

“It is therefore most respectfully prayed that this Hon’ble Court may kindly be pleased to:

a) Issue a direction / orders directing the Ld. Tribunal / Respondent no. 1 to pass judgement on merits in O.A 1106/2022 immediately for the reasons as stated in the present petition.



b) to stay retirement of the Petitioner and extend the service of the till the judgement on merits in the in O.A 1106/2022 is not passed. Further, it is prayed that, in the event the judgement is passed against the Petitioner, the Petitioner be granted extension of service for reasonable period of time to avail his remedy as per law.
