ORDER

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1. When the present petition came up for hearing on 18.01.2024, this Court was pleased to attach the accounts of respondent Nos. 1-5.
2. Since an Arbitrator has been appointed, the learned counsel for the parties states that the present Section 9 petition be treated as a Section 17 application and may be decided expeditiously by the Sole Arbitrator.
3. It is requested that the Sole Arbitrator will endeavour to decide the same within a period of 4 weeks from entering the reference.
4. Mr. Kumar, learned counsel for the respondents states that the balance in the 15 accounts mentioned in the order dated 18.01.2024 shall be maintained as of today.
