ii) Pass appropriate order(s)/direction(s) thereby directing the Court of Ld. CMM, New Delhi, Patiala House Courts, Delhi to hear and conduct the Criminal trial in FIR 77/2023 PS. EOW, in a lawful, fair and unbiased manner in the larger interest of justice.”



4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner without prejudice to his rights and contentions seeks leave to withdraw the present petition with liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
5. Liberty granted.
6. Needless to say that on petitioner initiating such proceedings, the learned Trial Court shall deal with the same in accordance with law.
7. Petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of.
