1. Allowed, subject to just exceptions.

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2. After some arguments, Mr Sudhir Nandrajog, learned senior counsel, who appears on behalf of the appellants, seeks to withdraw the appeal.

2.1 However, Mr Nandrajog says that the affidavit-in-reply dated 23.01.2023 was lodged with the Registry on the same date i.e., the date when signatures were appended on the affidavit.
