1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition is filed under Section 29(A) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for seeking extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal comprising of G.S. Palnitkar, Presiding Arbitrator, B.J. Vasavada, Co-Arbitrator, and K. P. Purushothaman, Co-Arbitrator.
