1. The Petitioner has approached this Court by filing the instant writ petition with the following prayers:-

“a) A writ of and/or directions in the nature of certiorari or any other appropriate writ, order or direction quashing impugned termination notice dated 29.12.2022 issued by Respondent no. 2;



b) A writ of and/or directions in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction for restraining the Respondents from illegally terminating the contract;
