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3. The present writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure ('Cr.P.C.') has been instituted on behalf of the petitioner praying as follows:

“In light of the above mentioned facts and circumstances, it is most respectfully prayed that, this Hon 'ble Court may be pleased to:-

a) Issue a writ in the nature of Mandamus granting parole to the petitioner for a period of ninety (90) days to the petitioner in FIR No. 387/2014, U/S 365/376D/392/506/34 IPC, P.S. Dwarka North; and/or in the alternate

b) Issue a writ in the nature of Mandamus granting third (3rd) spell of furlough for a period of two (2) weeks to the



petitioner in FIR No. 387/2014, U/S 365/376D/392/506/34
IPC, P.S. Dwarka North;

c) Pass such further order(s) as this Hon'ble Court deems
fit and proper.”

4. It is stated by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner that the present petition is before the concerned authority for appropriate relief.
5. Let this writ be treated as representation and the same be decided within two weeks, by the concerned authority, in this regard, in accordance with law.
6. No further relief is prayed for.
7. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
