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1. During the course of hearing, Mr. Bhatt, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case the dispute relates to dishonourment of cheque for sum of Rs.1.50 lacs. He, on instructions, submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to pay Rs.1.50 to the respondent.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions, submits that respondent is willing to accept this offer with respect to disputes related to the present cheque however, respondent will continue to press the claims/proceedings regarding the remaining disputes.
3. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has offered to settle the matter immediately on receipt of summons and notice. He, on further instructions, submits that the amount of Rs.1.50 lacs shall be paid to



the respondent by way of Demand Draft within two weeks. The undertaking given on behalf of the petitioner is accepted and taken on record and the petitioner is made bound by the same.

4. Considering that the offer of Rs.1.50 lacs is at the initial stage, the offence is permitted to be compounded and the complaint is quashed.
