1. This is an application for early hearing moved on behalf of the applicant/petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for respondent No. 2/RBI is present on advance notice.
3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner that since the RBI has agreed to reconsider their Representation dated 10.04.2023, the present writ petition may be disposed of, so as to enable the respondent No. 2/RBI to decide their representation in a time bound manner.
