2. This is an application seeking exemption from filing originals/certified/cleared/typed or translated copies of documents, left side margins, electronic documents, etc. Original documents shall be produced/filed, if sought, strictly as per the provisions of the Commercial Courts, Commercial Division and Commercial Appellate Division of High Courts Act, 2015 and the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.

3. Exemption is allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

4. Accordingly, the application is disposed of.

5. This is a petition filed by M/s. BIBA Apparels Private Limited under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension



of mandate of Id. Arbitrator. The dispute between the parties in the present matter pertains to an agreement dated 16th December, 2015 by which the Respondent was registered as a vendor for the Petitioner. Disputes had arisen due to failure of the Respondent in completion of the assignment given by the Petitioner and non-compliance of the contractual obligations. Thus, the matter was referred to Arbitration vide order dated 25th January, 2019. It is seen from the proceeding sheets of the Tribunal that the proceedings are at the stage of final hearing.

6. After having perused the dates and chronology of events, it is directed that the mandate of Id. Arbitrator shall stand extended till 30th September, 2024. It is made clear that Id. Arbitrator shall not give unnecessary adjournments to the parties.
