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1. This petition has been filed by the petitioner with the following prayers:

“It is, therefore, humbly prayed that this Hon'ble Court may please to allow this writ petition and may further be please to:

(i) Issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction thereby directing the ministry of Home Affairs to grant the benefits of Non-Practicing Allowance to the petitioners as parity with the Doctors of CRPF.
