1. This is a joint application on behalf of the parties seeking a consent decree as per terms of compromise enumerated in paragraph No. 2 of the application.
2. The aforementioned application is duly supported by affidavits of the Authorized Representatives of the parties. Counsel mentioned in the appearance above, confirm the compromise and pray that the suit be decreed in terms thereof.
