ORDER

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1. A perusal of the proceedings would show that on 16.03.2020, this Court had taken note of the nominal roll dated 09.03.2020 indicating that the appellant had undergone the entire sentence and had also paid the fine. The appellant was directed to remain present on the next date of hearing. However subsequently, the appeal could not be taken up on account of COVID-19 Pandemic.
