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1. The Petitioners have approached this Court challenging the Show Cause Notice bearing No.186-193/Joint CP/Lic./EH (FPO-12) dated 02.01.2024 issued by Respondent No.1, the Cancellation Order dated 24.01.2024 passed by Respondent No.2 and the Suspension Order dated 12.02.2024 passed by Respondent No.3.
2. An additional status report has been filed by the Joint Commissioner of Police, Licensing Unit stating that an Order has been passed on 11.04.2024 quashing the Impugned Show Cause Notice dated 02.01.2024.
3. In view of the above, prayer (a) of the writ petition stands satisfied.
