3. Since learned counsel for the respondent has appeared, the Caveat stands discharged.

4. The present appeal under Clauses X of the Letters Patent seeks to assail the order dated 15.01.2024 passed by the learned Single Judge in W.P.(C) 11128/2023. Vide the impugned order, the learned Single Judge has partly allowed the writ petition filed by the appellant by setting aside the award dated 31.07.2023 passed by the learned



Industrial Tribunal thereby remanding the matter back to the learned Tribunal for fresh adjudication of the respondent's claim on merits.

5. After some arguments, learned counsel for the appellant submits that instead of pressing the present appeal, the appellant will be raising all grounds including the grounds raised in the present appeal before the learned Tribunal.
6. The appeal is accordingly, dismissed as not pressed, making it clear that it will be open for the appellant to raise all grounds permissible in law before the learned Tribunal.
7. It is further made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the rival claims of the parties.
