1. Present application has been filed on behalf of the appellant, seeking permission to withdraw the appeal in view of settlement of disputes between parties under the agies of *Vivad Se Vishwas II* (Contractual Disputes) Settlement Scheme.

Learned counsel for the applicant states that during the pendency of the appeal, Government of India introduced a 'one time settlement scheme' dated 29<sup>th</sup> May 2023 titled "*Vivad Se Vishwas II* (Contractual Disputes) Settlement Scheme" to settle pending contractual disputes.
