1. The Petitioner is aggrieved by a Communication dated 11.01.2024 issued by the Respondents stating that the Petitioner has been blacklisted, and therefore, the Petitioner cannot be granted visa to enter the country. The said communication also indicates that the Petitioner could approach the Joint Secretary, Foreigners, Ministry of Home Affairs, Dhyan Chand Stadium, New Delhi for redressal of his grievances.
2. Material on record indicates that the Petitioner has already approached the aforesaid Officer on 15.01.2024.
3. Considering the fact that the visa application of the Petitioner is



pending since April, 2023, the concerned authorities are directed to dispose of the representation given by the Petitioner within a period of 10 weeks from today.

4. In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of, along with pending application(s), if any. It is made clear that this Court has not made any observations on the merits of the case.

5. It is always open for the Petitioner to approach this Court again in case the representation of the Petitioner is not disposed of within the time prescribed or the representation is decided against the Petitioner.
