1. The disputes between the parties stand settled. The settlement agreement dated 10 April 2024 is on record.
2. The petitioner has moved an application under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC to implead M/s ATS Infrastructure Ltd as Respondent 4.
3. As M/s ATS Infrastructure Ltd is a necessary party to the settlement, the request is acceded to. M/s ATS Infrastructure Ltd shall stand impleaded as Respondent 4.
