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1. The petitioner in the instant petition prays for the following reliefs :-

*“c) A Writ of Mandamus directing the Respondent to mutate shop No.3,
MB Road, Sector-1, Pushp Vihar, New Delhi in favour of the Petitioner.”*

2. Learned counsel appearing for the parties jointly submit that the controversy involved in the instant case can be resolved if the Court directs the respondent-Corporation to pass necessary order treating the instant petition as the petitioner's representation.
