1. By way of this petition under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, the petitioner seeks extension of the mandate of the learned Arbitral Tribunal, which is in *seisin* of disputes between the parties under a Master Service Agreement for Passive Infrastructure Services dated 30.06.2010.

2. The mandate of the learned Arbitral Tribunal has been extended from time to time, lastly by order of this Court dated 09.08.2023 in O.M.P.(MISC.)(COMM.) 247/2023 by six months from 01.09.2023 till 29.02.2024.
