1. By way of present bail application filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks interim bail for a period of four weeks in FIR No. 280/2022 registered under Sections 307/34 IPC at P.S. Sarai Rohilla on the ground that her son is getting married on 05.03.2024.
2. Issue notice.
3. Mr. Khanna, learned APP for the State accepts notice and opposes the bail application. He submits that though the injured has been examined, other material witnesses remain to be examined who are living in the neighbourhood of the applicant.
4. Since the marriage of the applicant's son already stands verified and a Status Report to that effect was filed before the Trial Court, it is directed that applicant be taken in custody to the venue of the marriage ceremony of the



applicant's son on 04.03.2024 at 10 am and brought back at 5 pm. The applicant be again taken in custody on 05.03.2024 at 10 am to the venue and brought back to the jail at 5 pm. The police officials accompanying the applicant on both dates shall go in plain clothes.

5. The bail application is disposed of in the above terms alongwith miscellaneous application.
