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1. The present petition under Section 482 of the CrPC seeks following prayers:-

“In the light of the above said fact and circumstances, it is therefore, most respectfully and humbly prayed that this Hon'ble court may graciously be pleased to :-

- a) allow the present petition, in the interest of justice;
- b) set aside the Judgment dated 20J22023 Passed By Ms. Gurmohini Kaur Ld., A.S.J-05, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi Passed In C.R. No.24112023 Titled As "Vijay pant Vs State And Anr"
- c) set aside the order dated 04.03.2023 passed by Ms. Swayam Sidha Tripathi Ld., MM-05 Dwarka Courts At New Delhi, where the charges were framed against the petitioner IJ/S 4984 and 406 IPC.
- d) Discharge the Petitioner from the charged framed against him vide order dated 04.03.2023 passed by Ms. Swayarn Sidha Tripathi Ld., MM-05 Dwarka Courts At New Delhi.
- e) Any other or further order/ relief as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, may also be granted in favour of the Petitioner and against the respondent.”
