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1. Parties have executed Settlement Agreement dated 20th February, 2024 before the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre, which is accompanied with Board Resolutions in favour of the authorised representatives of the Plaintiff and Defendant.
2. Counsel for the parties mentioned in the appearance above confirm the terms of settlement and pray for the suit to be decreed in terms thereof. Further, counsel for Plaintiff confirms that in terms of the settlement, the Defendant has handed over a cheque in favour of the Plaintiff for the amount of INR 1 lakh.
3. The Court has perused the said terms and finds the same to be lawful.
4. Accordingly, the present suit is decreed in favour of the Plaintiff and against the Defendant, in terms of the Settlement Agreement dated 20th



February, 2024, which shall form part of the decree. Parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement.

5. In view of the fact that parties have arrived at a compromise, Registry is directed to issue a certificate for refund of full Court fees, in favour of the Plaintiff.

6. Decree sheet be drawn up.

7. Suit and pending applications stand disposed of.
