1. The Petitioner has approached this Court for a direction to the Respondents to dispose of the application dated 04.06.2022 and the appeal dated 17.05.2023 and pass speaking order within a time frame.
2. The facts of the case in brief are that the father of the Petitioner Late Sukhbir Singh, who was the owner of the shop bearing No. D-434, NSM, Azadpur Mandi, Delhi, and a proprietor of the firms, namely, M/s Sukhbir Singh & Sons and Chaudhary Vegetable Company. It is stated that Sukhbir



Singh passed away leaving behind his wife, two sons and one daughter. It is stated that the shops as well as license has been given to the son, a fact which has been objected to by the Petitioner.
