By way of the present application filed under section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure 1908, the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition.

2. Ms. Sanjukta Roy, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the parties have settled their disputes under the “*Vivad se Vishwaas-II (Contractual Disputes)*” scheme, whereby the respondent’s claims have been accepted by the petitioner to the extent permissible under the scheme.
3. Ms. Roy submits that one of the requirements of the scheme is that after the claims are accepted, the petition must be withdrawn. Counsel however submits that if the respondent does not honour the terms of the settlement, the petitioner be given liberty to invoke their legal remedies, as may be permissible under law.
4. Issue notice.



5. Mr. Lovkesh Sawhney, learned senior counsel appears on behalf of respondent, on advance copy; accepts notice; and concurs in the submission made on behalf of the petitioner.
6. Accordingly, the petition is disposed-of as withdrawn, granting liberty to the petitioner to invoke their legal remedies, as may be permissible, in accordance with law.
7. Pending applications, if any, also disposed-of.
