ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the Petitioner is appearing through video conferencing and the Petitioner is present in person in the Court today.

6. In view of above, the present Petition along with pending Application is dismissed as withdrawn in view of the Settlement Agreement dated 05.10.2024.
