1. The petitioner has filed this application for deciding the matter on merits, but when the application is taken up for hearing, Mr. Naveen Kumar Chauhan, learned counsel for the petitioner, states that the petitioner is satisfied with the action taken by Municipal Corporation of Delhi ["MCD"] in respect of the unauthorised construction in *Property No. 78-B, Ward No. 1, Mehrauli, New Delhi* ["Subject Property"]. He therefore, seeks permission to withdraw the writ petition.

2. Mr. Aditya Vaibhav Singh, learned counsel for MCD is present and has no objection.

3. With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the petition is



taken on board and is dismissed as withdrawn.
