ORDER

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1. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State, at the outset, submits that pursuant to the impugned order dated 06.02.2019, granting anticipatory bail to the Respondent nos. 2 & 3, the charge sheet has already been filed.
2. He submits that the accused/ Respondent Nos. 2 & 3 are not required for any custodial interrogation.
3. It is pointed out that pursuant to the cognizance been taken by the learned Trial Court, the Respondent Nos. 2 & 3 were admitted on regular bail on furnishing a bail bond for a sum of Rs. 25,000/-.
4. It is not disputed that the conditions imposed by the



learned Trial Court while granting anticipatory bail have not been violated.

5. In view of the above, the present petition challenging the impugned order dated 06.02.2019 whereby anticipatory bail was granted to Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 is dismissed as infructuous.
