1. The instant application under Section 528 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (earlier Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973) has been filed on behalf of the petitioner/applicant seeking the following relief:-

“B. Change the Paragraph 12 of the Order dated 28.11.2024 in the instant proceedings to read as follows:

*"Taking into consideration the peculiar circumstances of the present case where the parties have resolved their misunderstanding which led to the instant FIR and in view of the settlement arrived at between the parties, the present petition is allowed. Accordingly, **FIR bearing No. 123/2023***
