1. The Petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayers:

“(a) Issue of a writ, order or direction in the nature of a mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction calling upon the Respondent to disclose all the necessary documents, information and look-out circular[s] issued and subsisting against the Petitioner before this Hon’ble Court; AND/OR

(b) Pass any such other writ or order(s) as it may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice.”

2. Ms. Nidhi Raman, learned CGSC appearing for the Respondent, states that one Look Out Circular (LOC) has been opened against the Petitioner at



the behest of DCP, Economic Offence Wing, New Delhi vide Ref. No.397/ACP/SEC-VII/EOW, New Delhi dated 19.12.2022 with regard to an FIR bearing No.166/22 dated 03.11.2022 for offences under Sections 420/406/120-B of the IPC. The statement is taken on record.

3. In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of on the statement made by the learned CGSC. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
