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1. The present petition has been filed seeking direction to the respondent to release the petitioner on furlough for a period of three weeks.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had moved an application seeking grant of furlough as early as in the month of December, 2023 but till date no decision on the same has been taken.
