ORDER

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1. This writ petition was preferred by the Petitioner seeking various benefits from Respondent No.2 such as outstanding salary and gratuity.
2. Learned counsel for the parties jointly submit that the Petitioner and Respondent No.2 have during the pendency of the writ petition resolved their *inter se* disputes amicably and Petitioner has agreed to accept a sum of Rs.5,35,736/- in full and final settlement of all his claims and has also signed an undertaking-cum-declaration to this effect. The amount has to be released to the Petitioner within two weeks from today.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of Respondent No.2, on instructions from Mr. Kamal (Law Officer) submits that the outstanding amount of Rs.5,35,736/- will be paid to the Petitioner within a period of two

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weeks from today, either through demand draft or through RTGS transfer. The undertaking given by Mr. Kamal (Law Officer) is taken on record and needless to state will bind Respondent No.2.

4. Writ Petition stands disposed, in view of the settlement between the parties. Pending application also stands disposed of.
